Here's what to do:

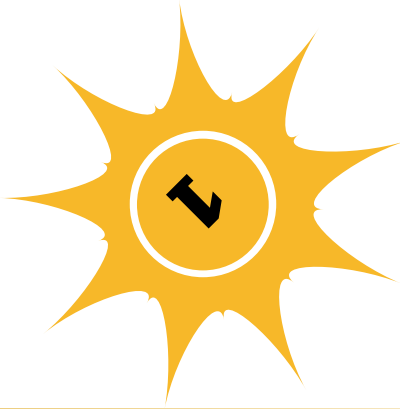
- 1** Tear each cootie catcher out of the booklet along the perforated lines as you're ready to make them. (There are 4 cootie catchers in total.)
- 2** Place the side with the circles-in-circles face up and fold each corner point into the centre.
- 3** Flip the cootie catcher over so that the flaps are face down.
- 4** Fold each corner into the centre again.
- 5** Fold the whole thing in half so the square becomes a rectangle and you make a crease down the middle.
- 6** Unfold and fold the whole thing in half the other way, so again, the square becomes a rectangle and you make a crease running the other way down the middle.
- 7** Stick both of your thumbs and both of your pointer fingers into the four pockets and push all of the pockets to a point.

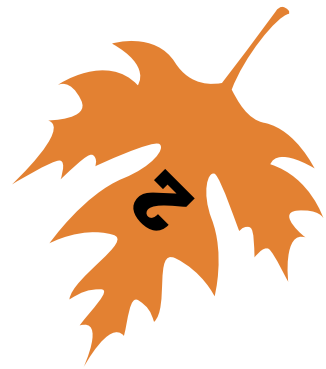
**HERE'S

When can sunglasses become a UFO?



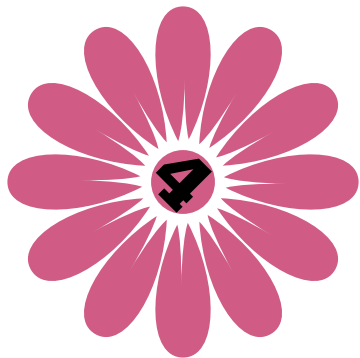
Skiing, snowboarding, hockey, rollerblading, and others!

Why are smoke alarms and Carbon monoxide alarms like school kids?

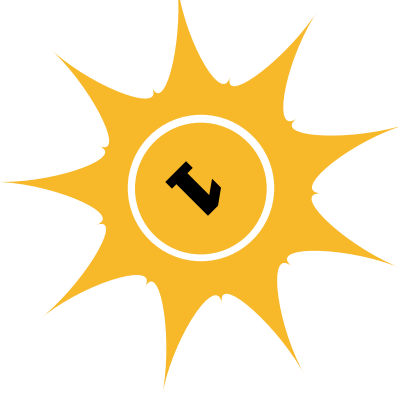
Two. At the top and bottom.

 Is it okay to run the car in the garage to warm it up?



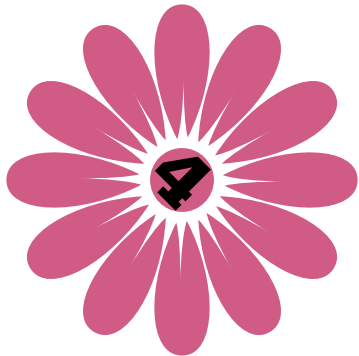
When the battery is dead or missing, remind your parents to change batteries twice a year!

 True or false. You can be turned away from a ride if you are too small.



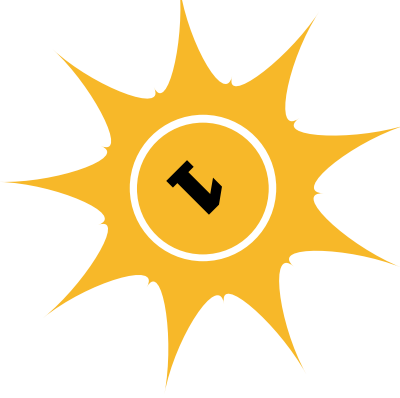
It has no colour - it's invisible, but it is very poisonous.

 True or false. Lowering the safety bar on the ski lift is only for beginners.

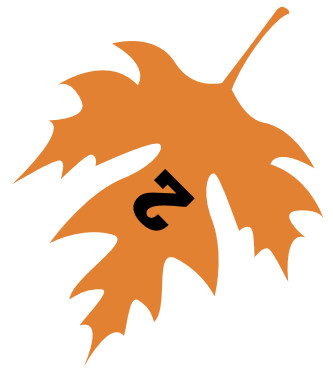




True or false. The glass on a gas fireplace is only hot when the fire is turned on.

Should a stroller be facing forward or backwards on the escalator?



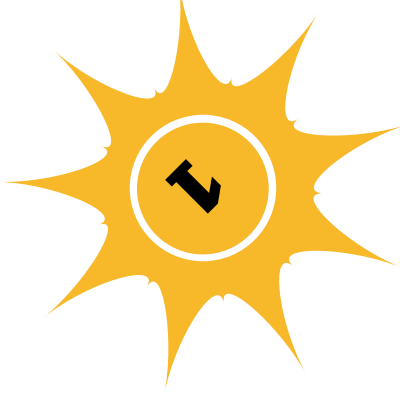
When you are on an amusement ride. Always keep your hands inside the ride.

Carbon monoxide - a poisonous gas!

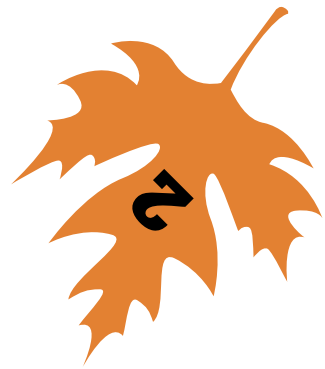
What is CO short for?





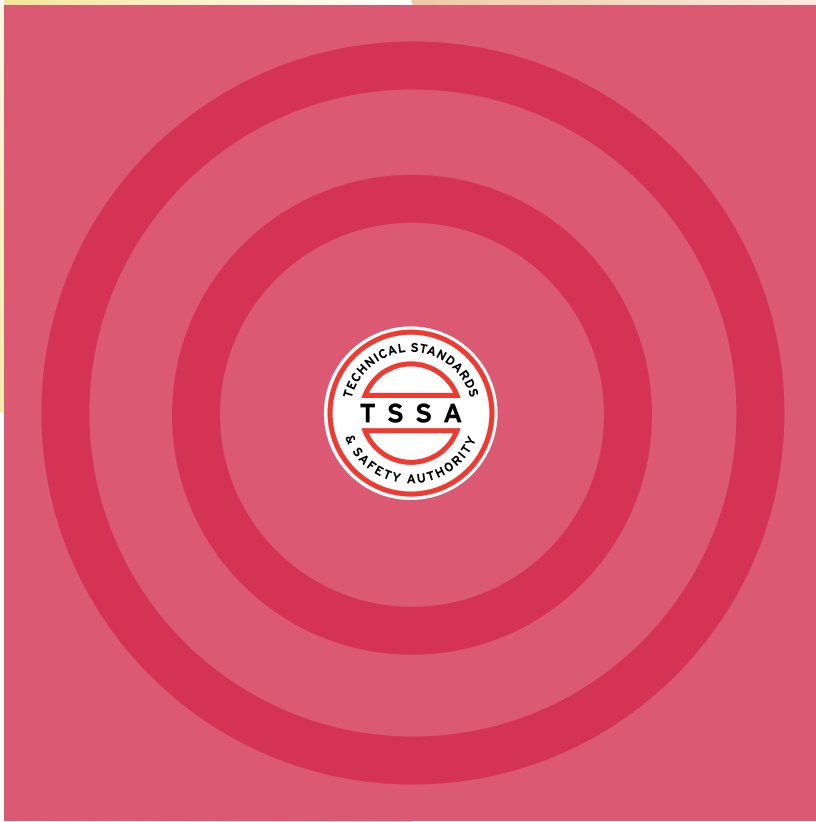
True. Tying hair back prevents entanglement. True or False. When riding a go-kart, hair longer than shoulder length should always be tied back.

Ring the alarm button and wait calmly. What should you do if you're stuck in an elevator?



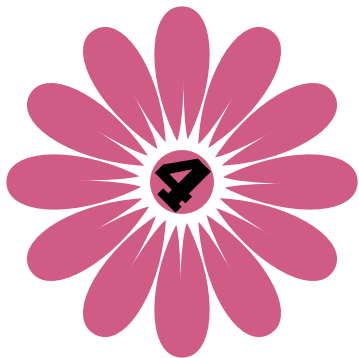
When riding on a ski lift, when do you lift the safety bar? When you see the sign "Raise Bar Here."

Get everyone outside and call 911. What should you do if you think there's carbon monoxide in the house?

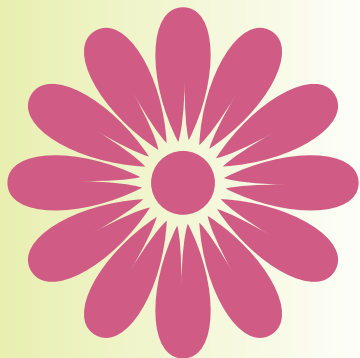
When an adult is not with you. When should you not play in the kitchen?

Neither. CO has no smell – but it is poisonous! Does carbon monoxide (CO) smell more like rotten eggs or a skunk?



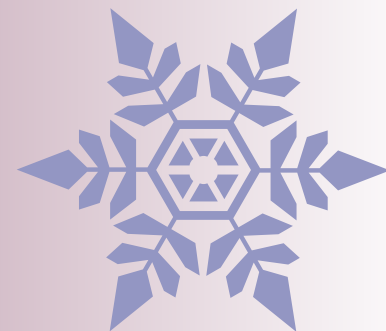

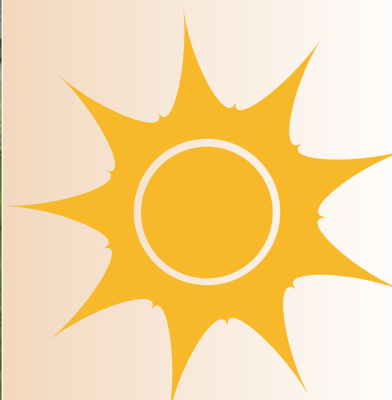
