Hey kids! Learn to be safe on escalators ...



You can use the down escalator to go up

Hold an adult's hand and keep feet away from the sides



It's okay to rest bags on the handrail



Don't ever take a stroller on an escalator. Use an elevator



Can you spot the differences?



When riding an escalator, always...

- face forward
- hold the handrail and/or an adult's hand
- Keep your feet away from the sides
